



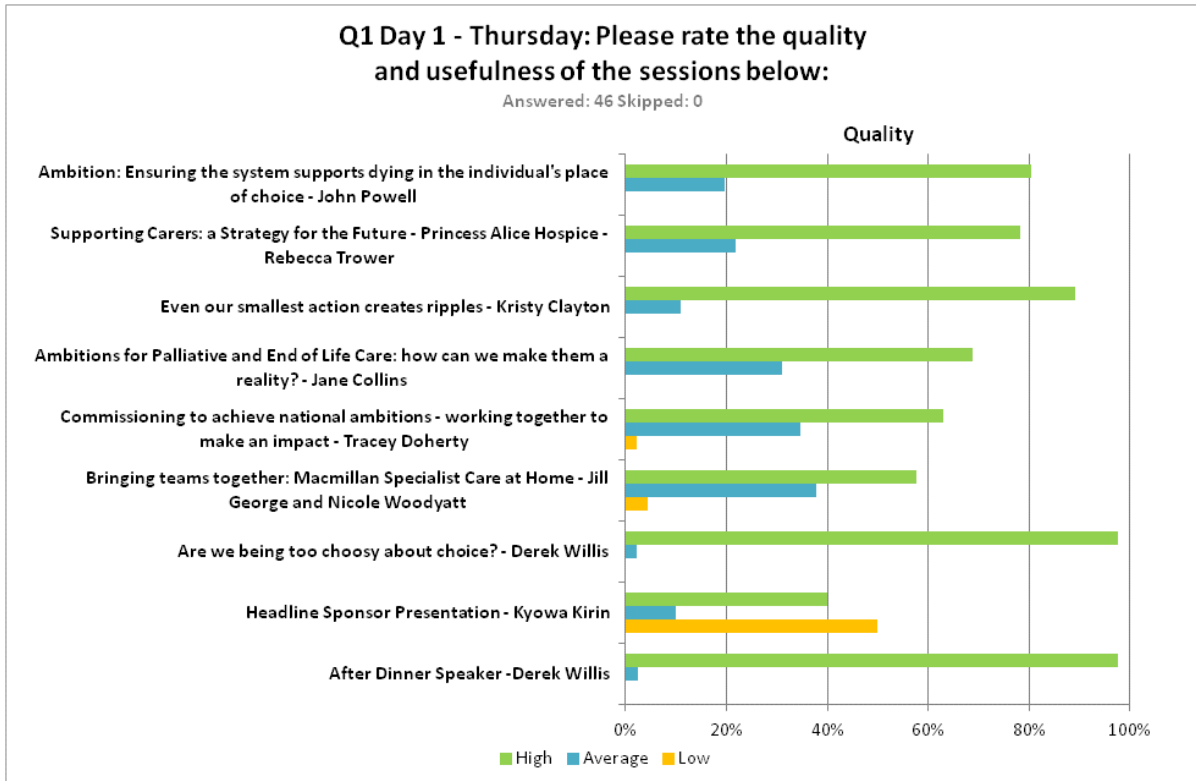

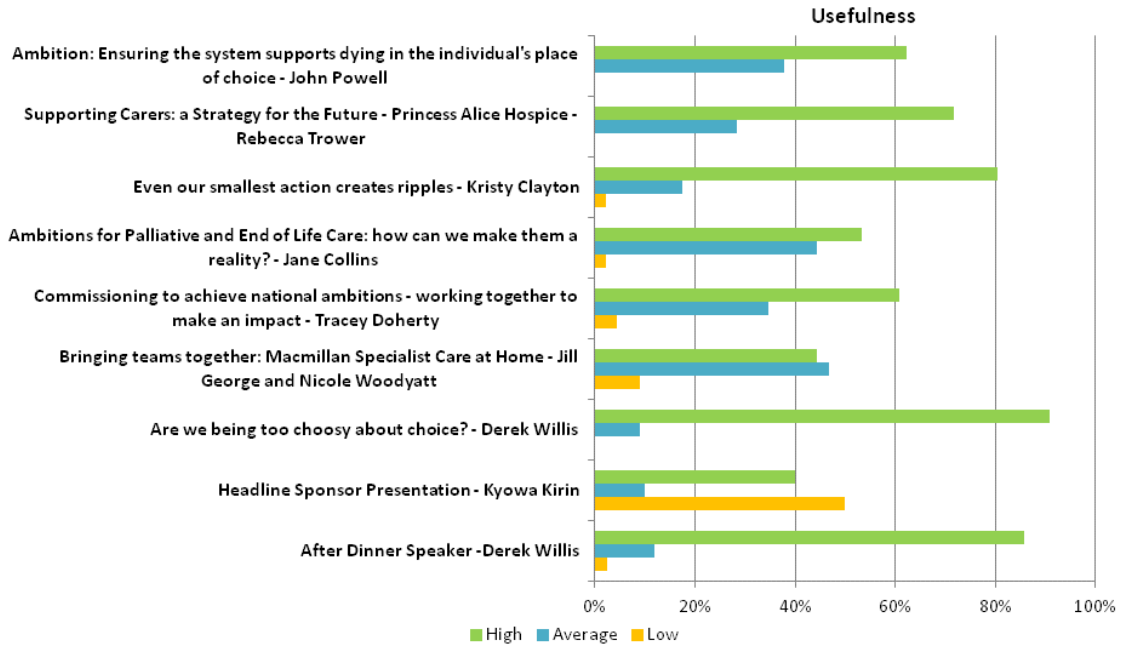

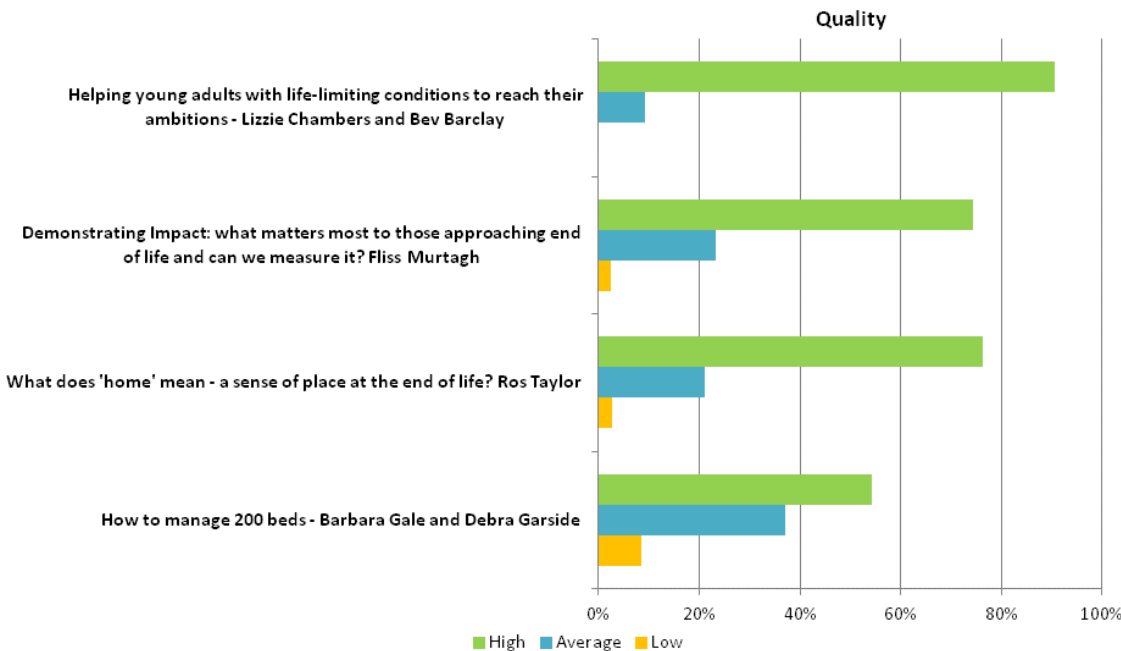
Q1 Day 1 - Thursday: Please rate the quality and usefulness of the sessions below:

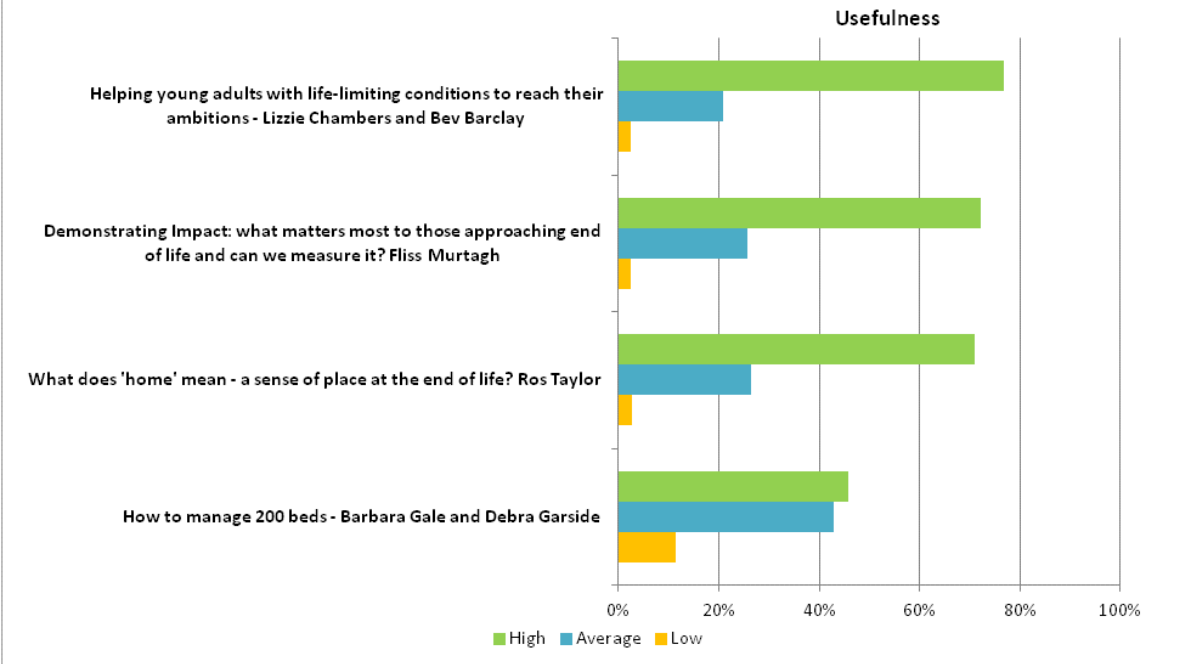
Q2 Day 2 - Friday: Please rate the quality and usefulness of the sessions below:

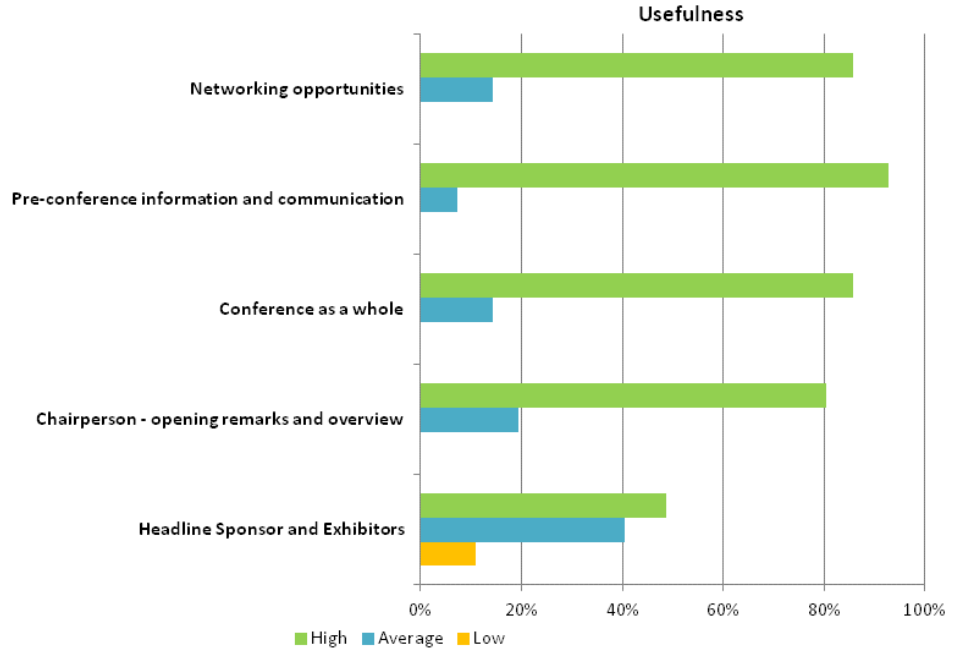
Q3 General Feedback: Please rate quality and usefulness.

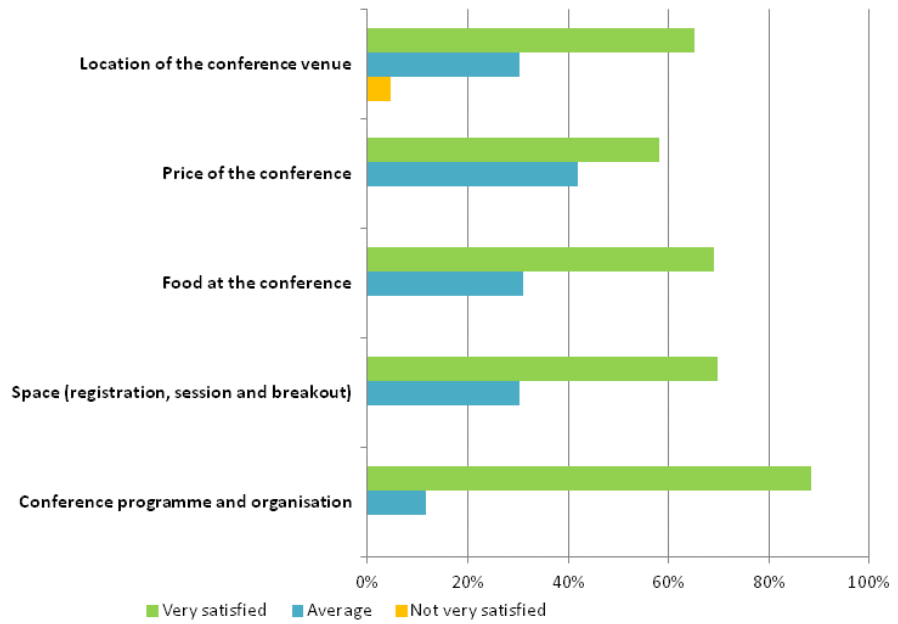
Q3 General Feedback: Please rate quality and usefulness.

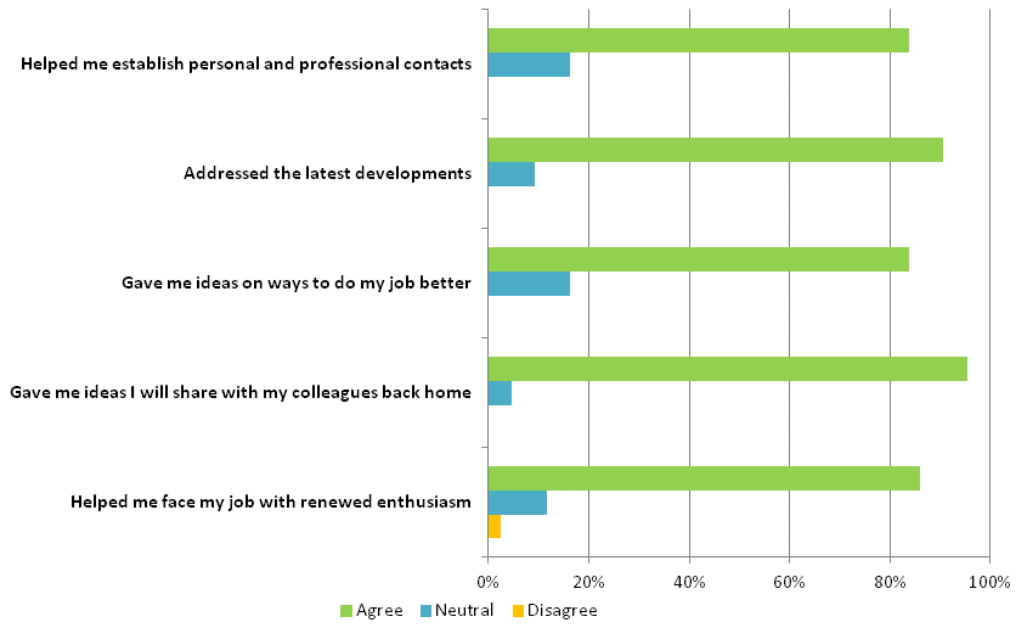
Q4 Please rate your satisfaction.

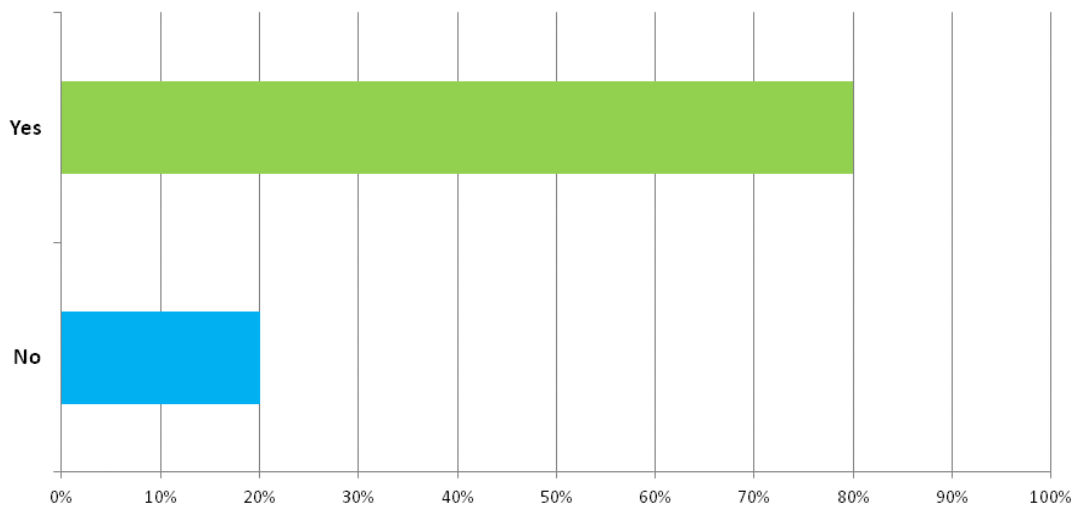
Q5 Please state whether you agree, disagree or neither.

The overwhelming comment related to the IT issues. This was raised formally with the hotel upon which the NAHH has received a written apology. Other issues relating to the hotel facilities & parking were also brought to the hotel Manager's attention.
